- The theory of production allocation and its contemporary significance for solving spatial development issues in Ukraine's economy.
- Analysis of Soviet structural policy and its long-term consequences based on Koropeckyj's methodology.
 - I.-S. Koropeckyj on the preconditions and prospects for market reforms in Ukraine.
 - Ukraine in the system of international economic relations: past and present.
 - Global economic development trends and Ukraine's prospects.



Requirements for theses: volume – up to 5 full pages (inclusive) of A4 format in the text editor Microsoft Word in the form of a file with the extension *.doc, *.docx; font – Times New Roman, pin - 14 pt; $line\ spacing$ – 1.5, paragraph – 1.25 mm, all margins – 20 mm; references are given in the text in square brackets – [2, p. 48]; references should be presented in the order they are mentioned in the text and designed according to the international bibliographic standard APA.

Working languages – Ukrainian, English.

The sequence of placement of materials in the theses:

- name and surname of the author/authors (font bold, alignment on the right edge);
- scientific degree, academic title, position, place of work/study (alignment on the right edge);
- name of the theses (capital letters, font semi-bold, alignment in the center) after 1 paragraph indentation;
- theses text after 1 paragraph indentation;
- References (font bold, alignment centered) with 1 paragraph indentation.
