

Meetings of the Council of Young Scientists in 2024

In 2024, the Institute's Council of Young Scientists held four online meetings, during which a number of issues aimed at supporting young scientists' scientific activities were considered.

In particular, during the meetings:

- Clarifications were provided on the conditions and procedure for participation in competitions
 - scholarships of the President of Ukraine and the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine for young scientists
 - grants of the President of Ukraine to support scientific research of young scientists
 - the Kyiv Mayor's Prize for remarkable achievements of youth in the development of the capital of Ukraine - the hero city of Kyiv
- An exchange of practical experience was organized on the implementation of scientific projects within the framework of competitions
 - grants of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine for research laboratories/groups of young scientists aimed at conducting research in priority areas of the development of science and technology
 - research projects of young scientists of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine
- Candidates for nomination from the Institute for:
 - scholarships of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine for young scientists were discussed
 - scholarships of the President of Ukraine
 - competition of the Council of Young Scientists of the NAS of Ukraine "Best Young Scientist of the Academy"
- Information was provided on the possibilities of publishing scientific articles in the Institute's professional publications, namely the focus and format of articles for the journals "Economy of Ukraine", "History of Economics and Economic Thought", "Ukrainian Society", "Economic Theory" and "Scientific Bulletin of the International Association of Scientists. Series: Economics, Management, Security, Technologies"
- Consultations were held on international scientific internship programs for young scientists, particularly the DAAD, Fulbright Research and Development Program and the Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program.

The meetings contributed to raising young scientists' awareness of the available opportunities for professional development and increasing their participation in scientific initiatives.
